Wellspring offers traditional classroom based and online courses for Addiction Counselor Certification, Certified Prevention Specialists and School faculties.

Addiction Counselors

Wellspring offers all 270 hours of addiction coursework required for initial credentialing as a Licensed (LCADC) or Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor (CADC) in New Jersey and many other states. Courses are offered through an interactive online format, and can also be used to meet renewal hours, continuing education credits, and professional development hours. We offer at least 60 hours of classroom based advanced coursework toward the renewal of these credentials

Prevention Specialists

Wellspring offers all 120 hours of prevention coursework required for initial credentialing as a Certified Prevention Specialist (CPS) in New Jersey. These courses may also be taken towards renewal hours for several other allied behavioral health professionals. Courses are offered in our comfortable training facility in East Brunswick, New Jersey.

School Faculty

Wellspring offers nine one-hour professional development courses in an online format for New Jersey teachers and other school staff. Courses meet Department of Education professional development hours related to substance abuse, child abuse, youth suicide, and bullying.
