We have an open door policy where parents may visit their children at any time without appointment. However, for older classes we encourage that our parents wait until after "school hours." Individual Parent/Teacher Conferences are scheduled twice a year for the older classes. Nevertheless, beginning and end of the day interaction between parents and teachers is always encouraged.
